FICTION:

On July 13, 2010, the Minister of Industry, Tony Clement, announced the cancellation of the Mandatory Long Form Census. In subsequent interviews, Minister Clement indicated that Statistics Canada officials support the cancellation.

FACT:

On July 21, 2010, Statistics Canada's Chief Statistician, Munir Sheikh resigned, stating "This relates to the question of whether a voluntary survey can become a substitute for a mandatory census. **It can not.**"

FICTION:

Minister of Veterans' Affairs, Jean-Pierre Blackburn decides not to appoint Veteran's Ombudsman, Stogran, to a second term.

FACT:
